US Department of Housing and Urban Development regulations require the City to hold a Public Hearing prior to the adoption of the C.D.B.G. Budget. The purpose of this hearing is to afford the public and various service organizations the opportunity to provide input into the use of the anticipated funds.

Program Year 2018/19 will commence on July 1, 2018. The City anticipates receiving \$711,680 for this fiscal year, of which \$604,928 will be available for allocation among various eligible projects. The 5-year Consolidated Plan which was developed in 2016 will govern the allocation of funds.

Public service activities are limited to 15% of the total program funding. The following service organizations were in attendance:
