Outreach Ministry

The Food Pantry is open Mondays and Thursdays from 1-4 p.m., and Fridays from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. You must have a photo ID.

Every day we are open, except Sunday, the "**Free Shelves**" are available. These shelves contain bread, crackers, tortillas, chips, and fresh produce as donations of such come in to the facility. It is requested a person take only what they can use, but they are welcome to take all they will use.

Meals are served Monday through Friday, at noon and at 5 p.m. Saturdays, lunch is served at noon. Volunteers are sought to serve Sunday evening meals so we can reinstate that program.

"AA" meets Monday through Saturday at 8:30am. This group is not church-sponsored, but has a long term relationship with Blessed Hope, and does an excellent job. We are blessed they are with us.

Limited shower and laundry facilities are available, but it is necessary to set up use in advance most days.



NIGHT WARMING CENTER

Open January through March when projected low temperature is 10 degrees or less, OR when wind chill is expected to be below 0 degrees.

Must be in by 11 p.m. Must stay in the building. No re-entry same night is allowed.

No cots or beds available at this time. You will sleep sitting up. Blankets and basic hygiene items are available. There is no storage facility to leave belongings during the day. You must take your belongings with you.

Continental breakfast served at 7 a.m. and all must be out by 8 a.m. or will do volunteer work to remain in the building. You may return for lunch at noon.

Daytime Warming/Cooling Center is open year-round from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday, as staff is available. We ask that folks help out by doing various tasks needed to keep the facility running – janitorial tasks, laundry, lawn and garden work, etc.

What Can You Do?

Dry cereals, soups, stews, and canned meats are always welcome. Peanut butter and jelly, macaroni and cheese, spaghetti, and canned fruits and vegetables are also needed for the food pantry. To help with the Welcome Center meals, #10 cans of fruit, vegetables, chili, beef stew and such are a real blessing. In addition, paper products, garbage bags of various sizes, cleaning supplies, food storage supplies, and other items are very much appreciated. Time spent serving or preparing food, talking with our guests, and so on is also wonderful!
