The City of Lincoln Park will hold a public hearing for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for sanitary sewer rehabilitation and Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan for the City of Lincoln Park lead service line replacement and water system improvements program. The purpose of the meeting is to present the Clean Water and Drinking Water System Improvements and to receive comments from interested parties. The hearing will be held during the Lincoln Park City Council starting at **7:00** pm on **Monday, March 11, 2024**. Interested residents may attend the meeting at the City of Lincoln Park City Hall.

The purpose of the proposed project is to provide lead service line replacement as required by the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) in June 2018 requiring all cities in Michigan to replace all lead water service lines. The project will involve water main replacement through a Pipe Bursting of the existing water main in nine (9) locations to upgrade the main in areas where scheduled road construction projects will be Commenced, this work includes upgrading valves and hydrants in these areas. The proposed project also includes Replacement of Lead Water Service Leads in these nine (9) locations and in various streets throughout the city as required by the Lead and Copper Rule (LCR) in June 2018 requiring all cities in Michigan to replace all lead water service lines. The water service lines must be replaced from the city-owned water mains within the street to 18 inches inside individual houses. The estimated cost of all the projects is approximately **\$11,517,480.00**. The typical household user would see a rate increase of **\$4.00 per month**.

The purpose of the Clean Water Projects is to provide rehabilitation to existing sanitary sewers, where structural defects, inflow, and infiltration. This Project will involve continuation of cleaning and televising the sanitary sewer system and smoke testing on various locations deemed necessary to identify and locate the source of inflow and infiltration to add the defected segments to the repair list for future projects. The estimated cost of the project is approximately \$1,980,000.00. The typical household user would see a rate increase of \$0.70 per month.
